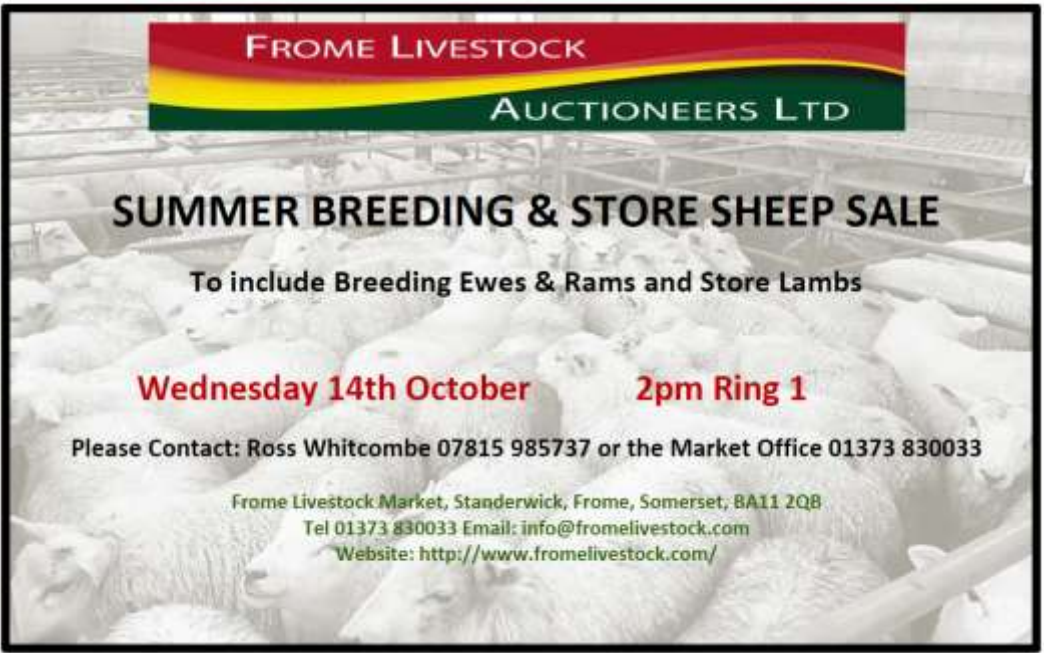

ORGANIC

A strong trade in this section with some quality forward types from Arminca Ltd, Blandford. Their well grown deep bodied 16mo Angus steers commanded premium prices to £2305! and £2200 respectively. More good sorts from the Tayler family saw 10mo steers at £1600 and 20mo heifers at £1880. More organics could have been well sold today.

COWS & CALVES

We saw the second consignment of quality cows & calves (1mo) from Windell Farming Ltd today. Demand was excellent and although none had been back to the bull the bidding was furious. Best Blue x cow with Limousin steer calf peaked at £3000, while Charolais cows & Limousin steers sold to £2890. Blue cows & Limousin heifers to £2540. Traditional Angus cows with young Limousin heifers were keenly sought to £2650.

GRAZING COWS

Some wonderful feeding cows (non-assured) from Windell Farming Ltd were regularly over £2000 with best Charolais £2390 and £2180. Leaner feeding types all wanted £1710 - £1440.

A few tidy sorts in this section all sold well. 19mo and 14mo Limousin rigs to £1460 & £1340.

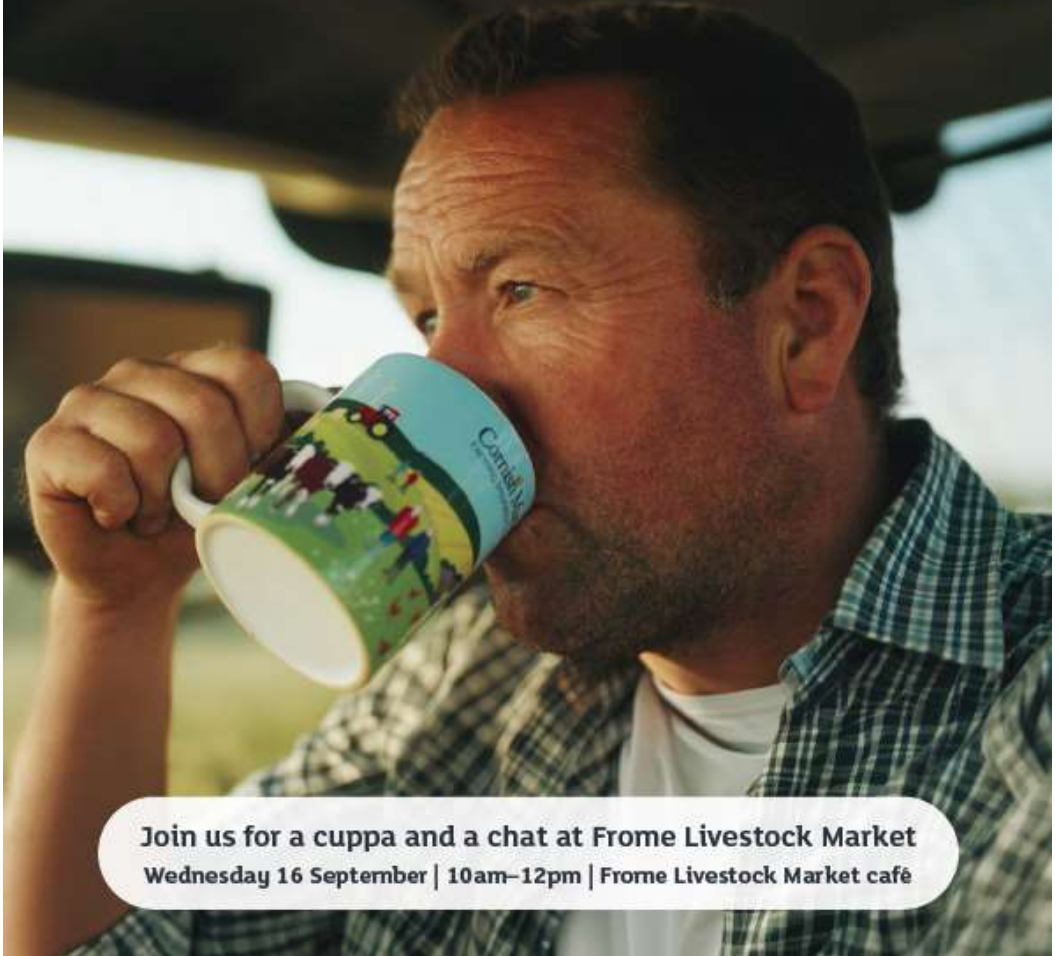
